

EDUCATION / TESTING ALLOWANCES FOR 2023

(January 1- December 31, 2023)

For all Maryland NAWGJ members (judges) in “good standing”
(Refer to NAWGJ Code of Professional Responsibility and Canons)

Testing	\$50 (one test)
Education (registration fee, travel, hotel, food (excluding alcohol))	\$450
2023 National NAWGJ Symposium (symposium registration, travel, hotel, food (excluding alcohol) to be used for the 2023 National NAWGJ Symposium. This is an additional allowance in addition to the above education allowance only to be used for expenses incurred during the 2023 National NAWGJ Symposium	\$200
Materials/Uniforms (USA Gymnastics, NAWGJ approved, Lands End uniforms)	\$75

Reimbursement requirements:

1. Member must be in “good standing” as defined by: (1) CPEs being current and recorded; (2) certifications and memberships up-to-date; and (3) no outstanding money owed to MDNAWGJ.
2. Allocation of maximum amount specific to that category will not carry over to another category.
3. Receipts must be submitted within 30 days of the event, purchase of materials or uniforms. Receipts can be submitted 30 days prior to the event. Reimbursements will be reviewed and returned within 30 days of receipt.
4. All funds must be used by December 31, 2023. *Unused funds do not carry over into the next year.*
5. If a member has been reimbursed or a fee paid on their behalf and they do not attend the event, MDNAWGJ must be reimbursed the amount within 30 days of the event.
6. If a member cannot attend an education event which was prepaid on their behalf, they will not receive additional reimbursements until monies from that education event have been paid back to MDNAWGJ.

Membership Reimbursements

Annual NAWGJ dues will be paid directly to NAWGJ for members in “good standing”.

USAG membership dues are reimbursable for members who set up or who were involved in pre-planning for the annual Judges meet. All MD NAWGJ committee members are expected at set-up.
